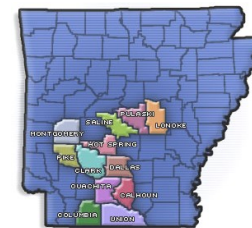

determine how you need to spend money and then will check to make sure your plan is being followed.

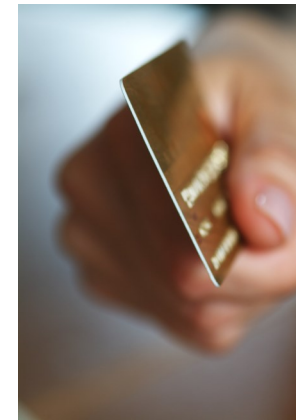
