

INCOME ELIGIBILITY CHART FOR REGULAR ASSISTANCE

For households required to apply for assistance on form DCO- 9495, income eligibility will be determined by comparing the household's Monthly Countable Income with the income eligibility chart below. The income eligibility limits are set at 60% of the state's median income level.

- (1) For each additional household member over the household size of 20, add **\$91.00** to the maximum MCI shown for a household size of 20.
- (2) MCI should not be rounded when using the eligibility chart. If the household's MCI is \$.01 over the level shown for the household size, the household is ineligible for assistance (see section 6341 for procedures for income computation).
