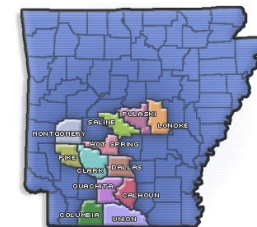

## What is Weatherization?

CADC's Weatherization program provides a wide range of measures to make homes more energy efficient, healthy, and safe. This is done as part of CADC's overall effort to help low-income people gain the basic necessities and achieve economic self-sufficiency.

Weatherization is a proven, long-term, effective solution to reducing high energy costs and conserving more energy in the home.

The CADC Weatherization program gives opportunities to householders to make their home more energy efficient when they may not otherwise be able to afford to do so.



## How does Weatherization Help Me?

Weatherization benefits low-income households and communities.

CADC's Weatherization program will provide computerized energy audits and uses other advanced technology to determine where the most energy can be saved in the home.



The program is available free of charge in the following counties to those individuals and families that meet certain income guidelines:

*Saline, Hot Spring, Clark, Pike, Montgomery, Little River, Nevada, Calhoun, Dallas, Columbia, Union, Ouachita, Garland, Polk, Hempstead, Howard, Lafayette, Miller and Sevier.*

After being approved for weatherization, CADC will invest up to \$5,000 in each home for energy efficiency measures.

By having this work performed, persons can expect to save as much as \$400 per year on energy costs.

## What Happens When my Home is Weatherized?

Weatherization of homes involves such things as:

- ★ Weather-stripping of doors and windows
- ★ Caulking and sealing cracks and holes in the building's structure



- ★ Insulating attics, walls, and under floors
- ★ Installing storm windows
- ★ Repairing and retrofitting furnaces
- ★ Installing hot water heater blankets
- ★ Replacing energy wasting refrigerators and gas hot water heaters
- ★ And other improvements that will help to seal energy inside the home.
