### How does the Program Work?

The Single Parent Scholarship Fund is designed to remove the barriers often associated with attending school. Funds are typically used for such things as transportation, gas, childcare expenses, books, and tuition.



After scholarships are awarded, CADC establishes an account for each recipient. Funds are managed and distributed by CADC. Each scholarship recipient is provided counseling, information, and referrals in the program.

Education and skill development are key components for an individual's success. CADC is committed to ensuring that all persons of society are valued and encouraged to accomplish their goals.

#### **Eligibility Requirements:**

- ◆ Resident of Clark, Columbia, Dallas, Hot Spring, Pike, or Saline County
- High school or GED graduate
- Single head of household with sole custody of at least one child under the age of 18
- Pursuing a career-oriented course of study
- Applicants cannot already have earned an undergraduate degree with the exception of those pursuing an M.A. in Teaching



- ◆ Income at 125% of the Federal Poverty Level
- Recipient of, or in the process of obtaining, a Pell Grant
- Willing to enroll in the CADC Family Development Program
- Must Maintain a Grade Point Average of 2.5
