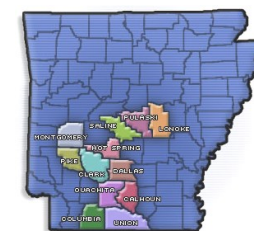

SCAT - South Central Arkansas Transit

SCAT offers a wide range of low-cost transportation services to the general public. Our services are offered in 11 counties and are designed to provide transportation to and from rural areas that previously had little or no transit services.



Transportation can include rides to and from medical facilities, shopping, personal needs, nutrition centers, and much more.

SCAT services include “deviated fixed-route” transit, “demand-response” or door-to-door transportation, transit for field trips, etc.

Medicaid Transportation

SCAT is also the Medicaid Broker for two regions in Arkansas. Clients that are eligible for Medicaid and have been approved for transportation are provided transportation at no cost to and from Medicaid providers only.
